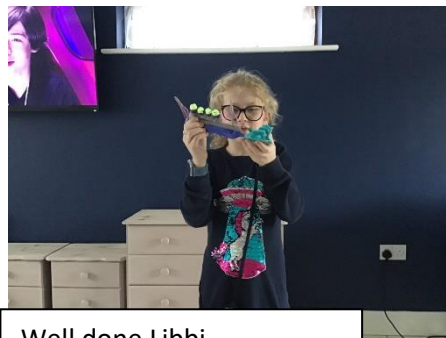

Suddenly, the large robot disappeared and little pieces went into the space ship. Then shot off into orbit as a star. The large robot had been...

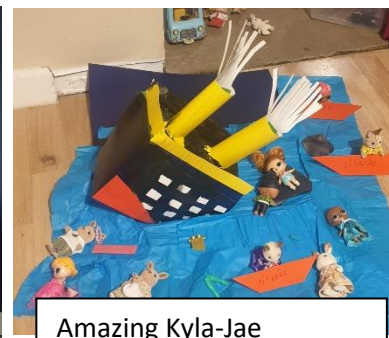
21/1/21 summary of the book

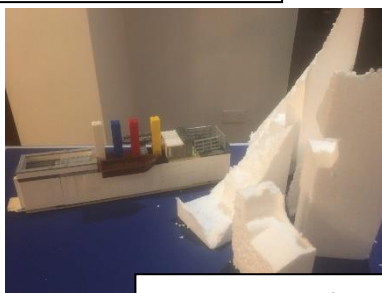

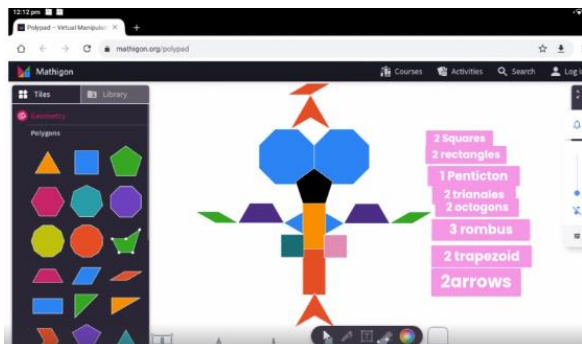

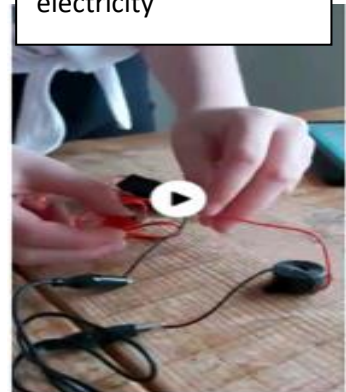
The iceberg is fantastic – it shows how big it was in comparison to the Titanic. Well done Jake
