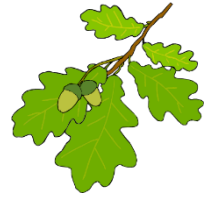

India Project

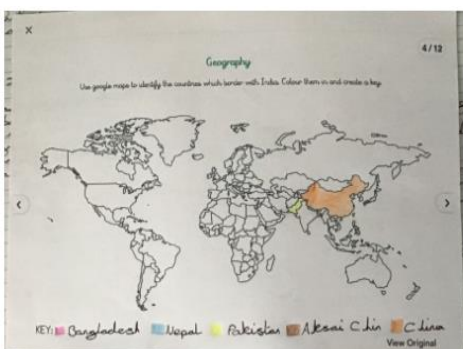

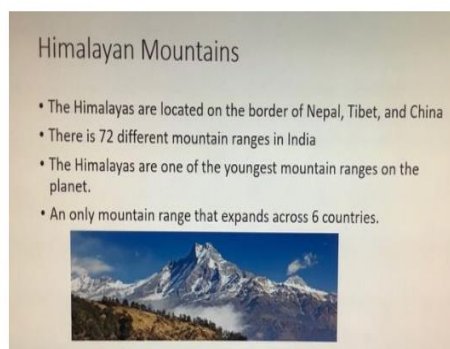

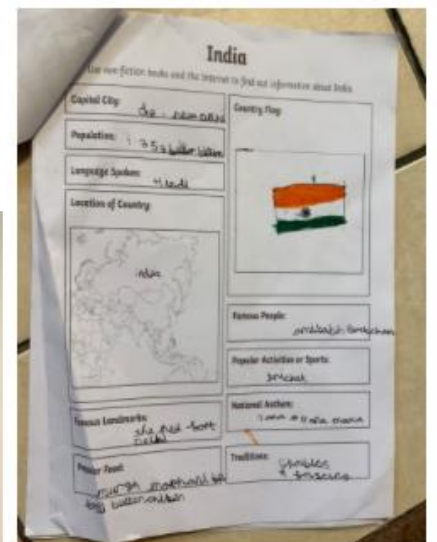

Microsoft Teams

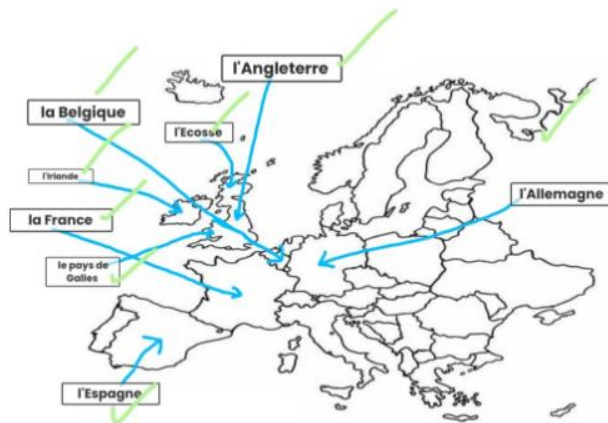

Reading Challenge

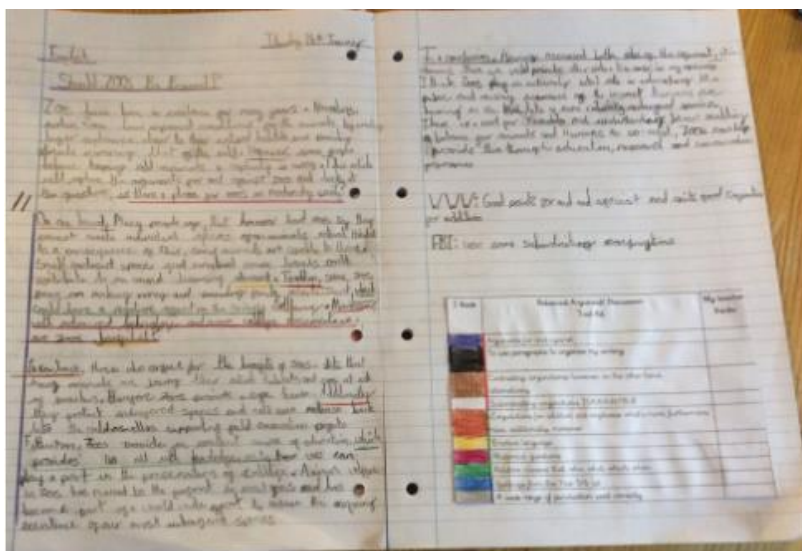
