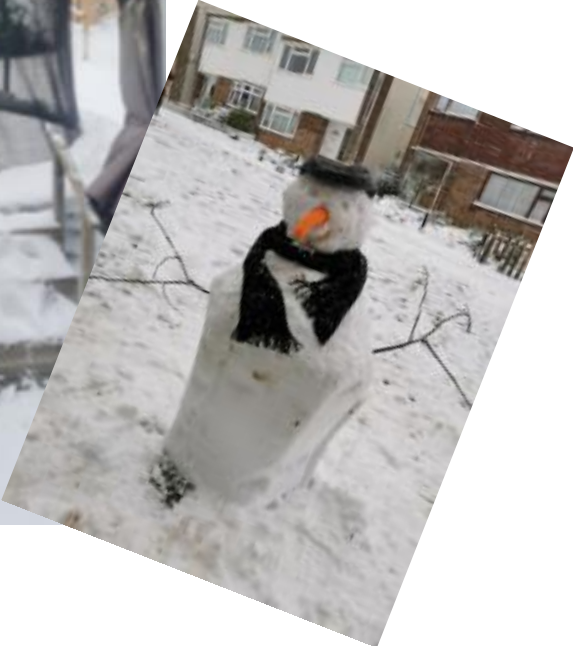
We celebrated Chinese New Year by making Dragon Masks, Lanterns and designing our own Willow Pattern
