

In Maths, we will be working on decimal numbers including identifying the value of each number and converting fractions to decimals. We will also be dividing 1 and 2-digit numbers by 10 and 100. We will also be calculating money in £ and pence and adding and subtracting money.

In addition to daily maths lessons, we will practice and further develop our arithmetic skills.

In PE, the children will be learning how to improve their hand-eye coordination and catching and striking the ball with a bat within cricket.

They will also be learning a range of Athletic skills such as long jump, sprinting, hurdles, and how to improve their performance.

In French, the children will learn the vocabulary for a hobbies. They will be able to speak and write in full sentences, giving their opinions on hobbies using adjectives.

In Computing, we will learning about computer networks including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the world-wide web; and the opportunities they offer for communication.

In Music the children will listening to rainforest music, giving their opinions and identifying the layers of the sounds.

In PSHE, the children will be learning about harmful substances and what we should be putting into our bodies to lead a healthy life.

In Art we will be learning about the artist India Flint and producing some printing work influenced by her.

In Reading lessons, we will be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts focussing mainly on inference, retrieval and vocabulary. We will also be reading Kensuke's Kingdom.

In English, we will be planning and writing the following genres:

- Non-chronological reports
- Persuasive letters
- Adverts

Within these genres, we will identifying the features and covering a range of punctuation and grammar tasks to support the children with their extended piece of writing. The children will learn a model text off by heart to base their writing on.



Rainforests

Sustainability—Responsibility—Stewardship

In Geography, we are exploring the question 'How safe is our future' through our Rainforests topic. We will be identifying the countries and capital cities of South America and comparing the geographical features of South America with the UK. We will be learning about the different layers of the rainforest and the creatures that live within them. In History, we will be learning about the Mayans and locating their era on a timeline. We will be learning about how they lived and looking at artefacts to see what we can learn about them.

In Science, we are learning about what it means to have a balanced diet and the nutrition food provides. Also, we will be learning about muscles and skeletons of both animals and humans.

In RE, we will be considering the question 'What would life be like in a world without colour?' by looking at different faiths. We will also be thinking about the question 'What difference does a Christian make to everyday life?'
