TITANIC SINKS IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ATLANTIC OCEAN!!!

RMS Carpathia has over 800 ill-fated survivors aboard. By Freya Simpson.



In the early minutes of Monday morning the great ship RMS Titanic sadly sank to the bottom of the Atlantic Ocean after colliding with an

iceberg. Over 1,000 crew and passengers - mainly passengers - are still missing.

Just 5 days ago, the Titanic set off from Southampton on its maiden voyage to New York City. Around 1,500 people paid between 3-8 ~~hundred~~ Hundred Pounds.

They had suggested this ship was 'unsinkable'. Operated by White Star Line, the Titanic was the biggest ship in the world, well known. Problems began at 11:40pm on Sunday 14th April hitting an iceberg on the starboard side at the hull of the ship. Whilst many passengers were sleeping, the Titanic was going at 22 knots - way too fast for an iceberg area.

Many people were lost including: Captain Edward Smith, Thomas Andrews, John Jacob Astor, Bruce Ismay and many more crew; ~~and~~ passengers.

The Titanic took 1-2 hours to sink and RMS Carpathia got there 4 hours later. The distress calls that they sent looked like gibberish through some eyes.

We believe that there is a possibility that the White Star Line will be sued for this tragic memory. We will be investigating this story for much longer as it has only just been launched - the investigation.
