The Book fair will be in the school atrium from 3-4pm on Tuesday 9th until Thursday 11th May. Please pop by and have a look with your child/children.



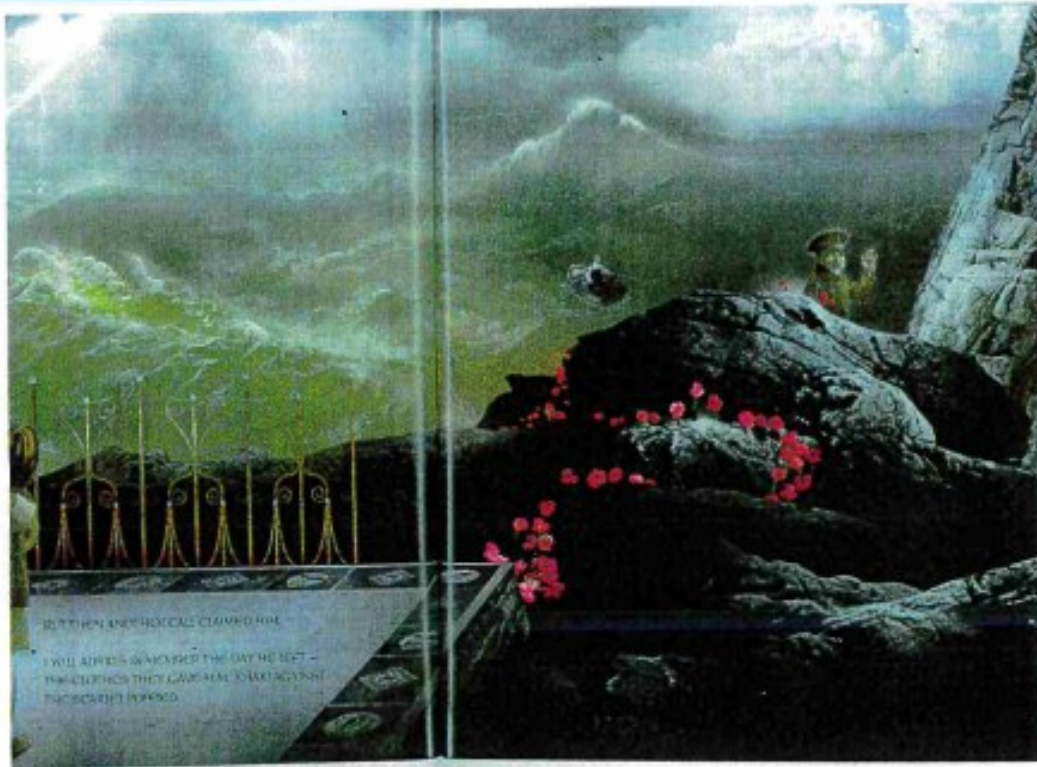
