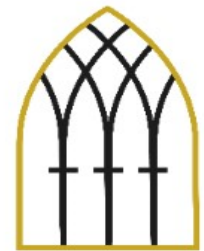

### Prime Drink Bottles

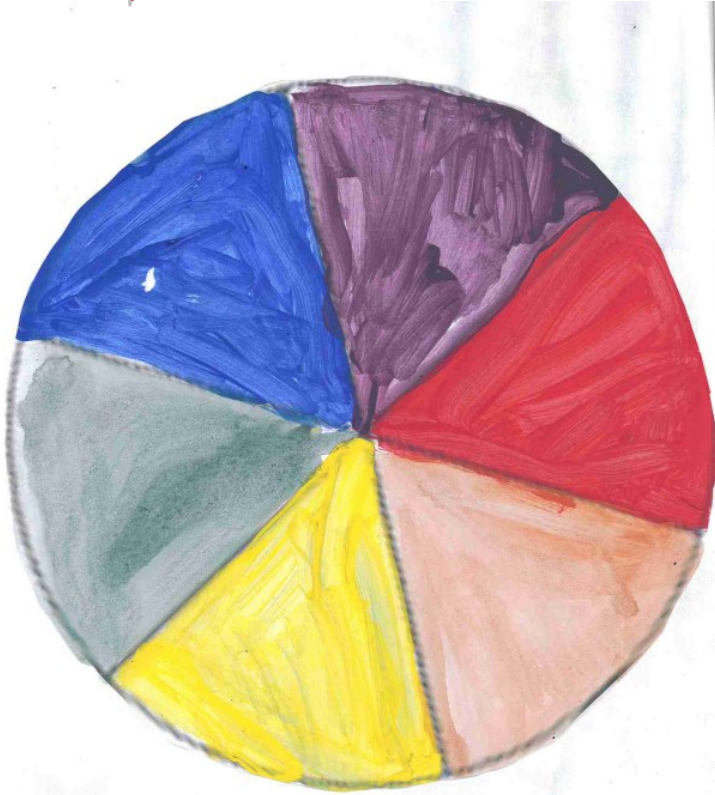
Please be aware that Prime drinks bottles are NOT allowed in school, even if they are just re-filled with water.

28<sup>th</sup> April we used our own painted paper like gouache.

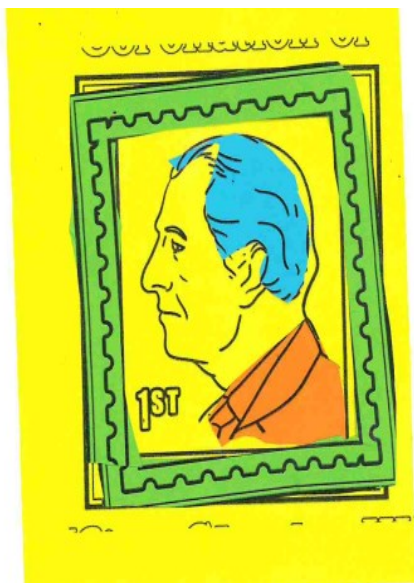
5<sup>th</sup> May we used tissue paper, which has translucent properties.
